March 30, 2016

The Annual Town Meeting convened on March 29, 2016 in the Bedford High School Auditorium. The Moderator called the Annual Town Meeting to order at 7:31 p.m.

Article 12 – Zoning Bylaw Amendment-Building Height declared necessary two-thirds having been met (Yes-155, No-42). Article 13 – Zoning Bylaw Amendment-Revised Flood Insurance Rate Maps passed unanimously on voice vote meeting two-thirds requirement. Article 14- Zoning Bylaw Amendment-Limited Business District (from ZBA) declared motion having been passed with the necessary two-thirds met. Article 15-Bedford Business Zoning Appropriation declared passed. Article 16-Land/Easement Acquisitions for Middlesex Turnpike and Great Road/Mudge Way Intersection declared the two-thirds met unanimously. Article 17 – Mudge Way Street Acceptance passed by majority vote. Article 18 – Bond Authorization – Job Lane School Addition passed unanimously. Article 19 – Proposed FY2017 Capital Projects Plan declared motion for those items adopted unanimously-Projects 17-01, 17-02, 17-04, 17-05, 17-06, 17-07, 17-08, 17-10, 17-12, 17-13, 17-14, 17-15, 17-17, 17-18, 17-19, 17-21, 17-23, 17-24, 17-25. Project 17-03 declared the motion passed. Project 17-11 declared the motion passed by majority voice vote. Project 17-16 declared the motion passed on voice vote. Project 17-20 declared motion passed unanimously. Project 17-22 declared motion passed unanimously. Project 17-26 declared the motion passed unanimously. Project 17-27 declared this motion passed unanimously.

The Moderator stated capitol articles 17-28-17-32 will be discussed and voted on separately due to bonding.

Project 17-28 declared the necessary two-thirds has been met unanimously. Project 17-29 declared the two-thirds has been met unanimously. Project 17-30 declared motion passed. Project 17-31 declared two-thirds met and project passed.

The Moderator stated due to a motion to adjourn, Article 19-Proposed FY2017 Capital Projects Plan Project 17-32 is still open and will be the first continued Monday night.
