One Heavy Equipment Operator position has become available in the Bedford Department of Public Works for a mature individual to perform various public works jobs of substantial complexity and to operate a variety of small and large construction equipment. Work requires a frequent and high level of physical effort under sometimes adverse weather conditions. Proven ability to operate construction equipment such as backhoes, front end loaders, and heavy plowing equipment.

Qualifications include a High School diploma, a valid Massachusetts Class B Commercial Driving License and a 2B/1C Hydraulic Hoisting License, and a proven good driving record, as evidenced by a Registry of Motor Vehicles report. Experience in turf care including athletic field maintenance is required and a Massachusetts Pesticide Applicator's License is highly desirable.
