Articles 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17 - We approve the amendments adopted under Articles 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, and 17 at the Bedford Annual Town Meeting that convened on April 1, 2013.

Note: Pursuant to G.L. c. 40, § 32, neither general nor zoning by-laws take effect unless the Town has first satisfied the posting/publishing requirements of that statute. Once this statutory duty is fulfilled, (1) general by-laws and amendments take effect on the date these posting and publishing requirements are satisfied unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law, and (2) zoning by-laws and amendments are deemed to have taken effect from the date they were approved by the Town Meeting, unless a later effective date is prescribed in the by-law.
