



## **HEAVY EQUIPMENT OPERATOR DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC WORKS**

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The Town of Bedford (pop. 14,329) is searching for two full-time (40 hrs/week) Heavy Equipment Operator for its busy Public Works Department. Duties include performing various public works tasks of substantial complexity and to operate a variety of small and large construction equipment. The position requires a frequent and high level of physical effort under sometimes adverse weather conditions. Proven ability to operate construction equipment such as backhoes, front end loaders, and heavy plowing equipment is required.

Qualifications include a High School diploma, a valid Massachusetts Class B Commercial Driving License and a 2B/1C Hydraulic Hoisting License, and a proven good driving record, as evidenced by a Registry of Motor Vehicles report. Experience in trenching, paving, grounds keeping, pumps, sewer, sewer stations, and plowing are required with confined space and mechanical knowledge highly desirable.

The hours for this position are Monday through Friday, 40 hours, in addition to mandated overtime during weekend interments and other emergencies. Starting salary for this position is \$21.01 per hour. The Town of Bedford offers a comprehensive benefits package.
