All applicants must have successfully graduated from a full-time MA Municipal Police Training Committee Academy. Applicants must also have Full-Time Police status under MGL Ch.31, to be eligible.

Additional requirements:

- Excellent attendance and performance rating throughout one's entire career without imposition of any formal discipline.
- A release from their department indicating the appointing authority grants approval for a lateral transfer if selected for the position as a Town of Bedford Police Officer.
- Have and maintain permanent residence at the time of application in a city or town within 10 miles of Bedford, as defined in MGL. Ch. 41 & 99A.
- Have a current MA driver's license in good standing and a current unrestricted LTC.

The Town of Bedford offers a very competitive salary and benefits package, including full Quinn Bill benefits for those who earned degrees prior to October 1, 2009 or an alternative career incentive program for those who earned degrees on or after October 1, 2009.
