The Town of Bedford is seeking an energetic candidate for a Group Leader position in the Bedford Recreation Department KIDS' CLUB. KIDS' CLUB is an after school care program servicing students in Grades K-5.

This position would be responsible for planning and facilitating activities for school age children of all ages and learning abilities. Candidates must be able to work well with all age groups. Verifiable experience working with school-age children (as a coach, gymnastics or dance teacher, a camp counselor, etc.) is required.

First Aid and CPR certification (or ability to obtain such certifications) is required and may be paid for by the program. The ability to be a team player is a must. If hired, candidates must be willing to submit to all criminal (CORI), sex offender (SORI), and DCF (Dept. of Children and Families) background checks, and complete a pre-employment physical including drug screen.

The school year hours for this position are Monday through Friday, 2:00-6:00 p.m. Optional additional hours will be available for the full day programs which run during school and summer vacation periods.
