PART-TIME ELECTRICAL INSPECTOR CODE ENFORCEMENT DEPARTMENT

The Town of Bedford (pop. 14,020) is searching for a Part-Time Electrical Inspector for its Code Enforcement Department. Duties include, but are not limited to, enforcing the most recent edition of the National Electrical Code and Massachusetts Electrical Code (527 CMR, 12.0), up to and including performing various inspections for commercial, industrial and residential projects, maintaining accurate records of each inspection performed, writing violation notices and responding to electrical-related emergency calls.

Successful candidates must have experience in both commercial and residential work; possess a valid Masters Electricians License, a valid Massachusetts Class D driver's license with reliable transportation and basic computer skills. Proper dress required.

The Electrical Inspector's office hours are from 8:00 a.m. to 9 a.m., with inspections conducted from 9 a.m. to 12 p.m., Monday through Friday. This is a 20 hour a week position with a starting salary range between \$25.24/hour and \$29.33/hour depending on experience. This position is also eligible for the Town of Bedford's comprehensive benefits package.
