Traffic Supervisor Town of Bedford

The Town of Bedford (pop. 14,503) is seeking Traffic Supervisors to direct and control traffic to insure its smooth and safe flow in Bedford. Traffic Supervisors are appointed by the Chief of Police and are responsible for directing traffic at assigned locations in such a manner as to fully protect the safety of the public, while at the same time providing for the orderly and safe movement of vehicular traffic.

The successful candidate will have knowledge of applicable Federal, State and Local laws, codes and regulations; Department regulations, policies, and procedures; and procedures for directing traffic. Ability to work outside in a variety of weather and temperatures is a must.

Requirements for the job include a high school diploma or G.E.D., as well as training and certification in CPR and First Responder. Candidates must be a Full-Time Police Officer Academy Graduate or completed a Reserve Intermittent Training Course.

Must possess, or be able to obtain by hire, a valid Class D State Driver's License. Must be capable of obtaining a Massachusetts License to Carry a Firearm and maintain qualification.

This is an unpaid position with the Town and volunteer hours are expected throughout the year. This position has the ability to work road side construction details. The position is not eligible for benefits.
