

**HISTORIC DISTRICT COMMISSION

PETITION #006-16 – Suzanne Kohler, 90 Great Road, for new paint color on building.

Ms. Kohler greeted the Commission and explained that they had been renovating the building at 90 Great Road and were now re-siding it. She said that the construction workers had used a gray primer on the siding and many people involved with the project, herself included, thought that gray looked better than the white. She stated that the gray was especially desirable because it better showcased the Greek Revival architectural details on the building which were sometimes lost with the white paint. She added that the only other request was to paint the window mullions black; she passed out a photograph of a historic building in Cambridge with black mullions, and she noted that she loved the look.

After discussing more details of the paint colors, Mr. Moonan called for a motion.
