1. Call to Order

2. Old Business

a. Review Transportation Advisory Applications

Mr. Piantedosi moved to recommend Kelly Dadah for an interview with the Selectmen for the Community Preservation Committee. Ms. Kelley seconded the motion.

The motion passed 3-0-0.
