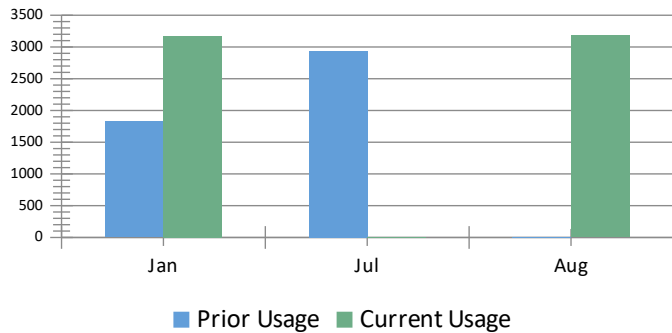

1. Account Number – This identifies you and your property address in our billing system. Please use this number whenever you contact us with questions about your account.
2. Service Period: This is the period between the previous meter reading and the current meter reading, time period where the usage is recorded.
3. Bill Date – This is the date the bill was issued.
4. Due Date – This is the date that your payment must be received by the Town of Bedford to avoid interest charges.
5. Rate structure – Shows current Water / Sewer and Irrigation rates with which the bill is calculated and the period it is calculated for (bi-annual or quarterly).
6. Meter ID – shows the number of meters on your property. Typically, water meters are separate from irrigation meters and their usage rates are also different. Domestic water meters will have a sewer charge and Irrigation meters do not have a sewer charge.
7. Bill Code – This is the type of meter read conducted. Refer to table below:

Bill Code	Description
A	This is an Actual read recorded by the water meter.
E	This is an Estimated read. Common reasons for having an estimated read are that the meter is inaccessible or was disconnected from the wiring or the meter signal is not working properly. You must contact the Water Division to schedule a meter change out. If you are a commercial property with a meter size larger than 1 inch, you will be provided instructions to purchase a new meter per the Town- bylaws.
F	This is a Final read for the water usage by the current property owner. Typically, you would see this code if the property is sold to another owner.
R	This type of bill code occurs when the meter was Replaced. You may see multiple lines for each meter. Water usage recorded by the old meter and the water usage recorded by the new meter will be included.

8. Usage – This is the usage for this bill. This is the total cubic feet of water consumed by the property between the previous meter reading to the present meter reading.
9. Total Due – This is the amount due by the due date. It includes the amount of your current bill and any unpaid previous bills, if applicable.
10. Service Address – This is the property location where the service is provided.
11. Billing Address – This is the property where the bills are mailed to. Typically the service address is the same as the billing address, unless the bills are paid by a property owner residing elsewhere.
