

Historic House Plaques Project

The Historic Preservation Commission (HPC) has a continuing program for providing assistance to property owners who wish to place historical plaques on their residences or other buildings. The HPC works cooperatively with a supplier who makes the plaques to our HPC approved design. Applications are available from the HPC via this website and the Town Manager's office.

Two styles of signs are available: Bedford Style #1 is 12" x 16"), and Bedford Style #2 is 8" x 12". Both are made of MDO weatherproof signboard, finished with 3 coats of special sign painter's oil based primer and enamel topcoat. Holes are pre-drilled and screws are provided. Space is provided for up to 4 lines of copy (Style #1) or 2 lines (Style #2), with white background colour, and black letters, all hand painted.

On receipt of an application, the HPC will verify the original construction date by researching available original documentation, including the Registry of Deeds for Middlesex County. After verification, the application is sent to the supplier, who will then deal directly with the applicant relative to the making and the payment for the plaque.
