EEE Risk Level	What it means	What you can do
Remote	EEE not usually found in your area	1. Repair window screens
Low	EEE may occur in your area	2. Wear mosquito repellent from dusk to dawn 3. Wear long sleeves and long pants from dusk to dawn 4. Use mosquito netting on baby carriages and playpens
Moderate	EEE occurred in your area within the last year and/or there is EEE in mosquitoes in your area now	5. Wear mosquito repellent while outdoors, especially between dusk and dawn 6. Avoid areas with obvious mosquito activity
High	Conditions likely to lead to infection of a person in EEE are occurring in your area	7. Adjust outdoor activity to avoid peak mosquito hours (from dusk to dawn) 8. Avoid overnight camping, particularly near freshwater swamps where EEE is most likely
Critical	Excessive risk from EEE virus exists, a person with EEE infection has been identified in your area	9. Cancel or reschedule outdoor gatherings, organized sporting events, etc., to avoid peak mosquito hours

WNV Risk Level	What it means	What you can do
Low	Infection with WNV is unlikely	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Be prepared: know your risk – check this page regularly, repair screens, clean up to get rid of mosquito breeding sites, be aware of stagnant water on private property (i.e. unused swimming pools) and consult the LBOH 2. Wear mosquito repellent from dusk to dawn 3. Wear long sleeves and long pants from dusk to dawn 4. Use mosquito netting on baby carriages and playpens
Moderate	Infection with WNV is likely or has already occurred	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 5. Wear mosquito repellent while outdoors, especially between dusk to dawn 6. Dump standing water at least twice weekly
High	More people may get infected with WNV in your area	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 7. People over 50 years old or those who are immunocompromised should adjust outdoor activity to avoid peak mosquito hours (dusk to dawn)
Critical	An unusually high risk of WNV exists in your area	Situation specific recommendations will be made
