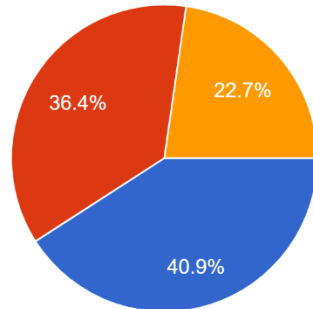


Did you notice any effect on the volume of trash your household generated each week as a result of this food waste program?

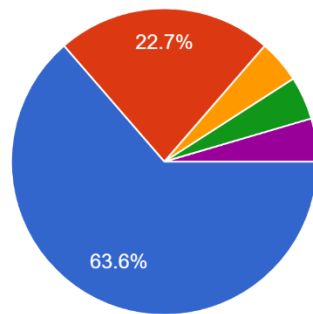

How would you rate the overall value of curbside food waste collection service?

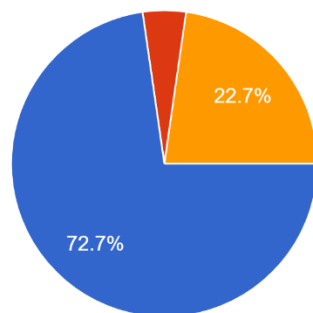

Has your opinion about composting changed as a result of this program?

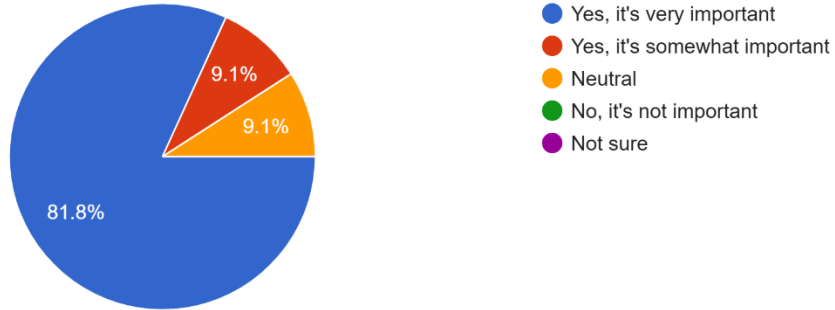

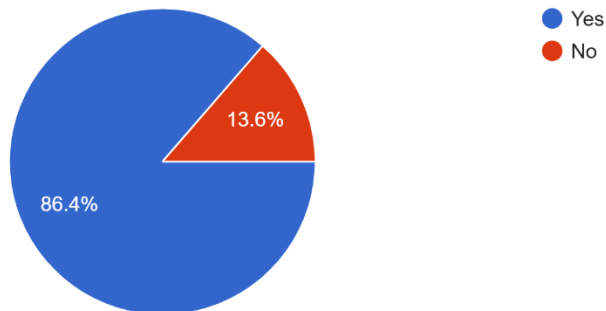
Do you think that composting your food waste makes a noticeable positive impact on the environment or community?

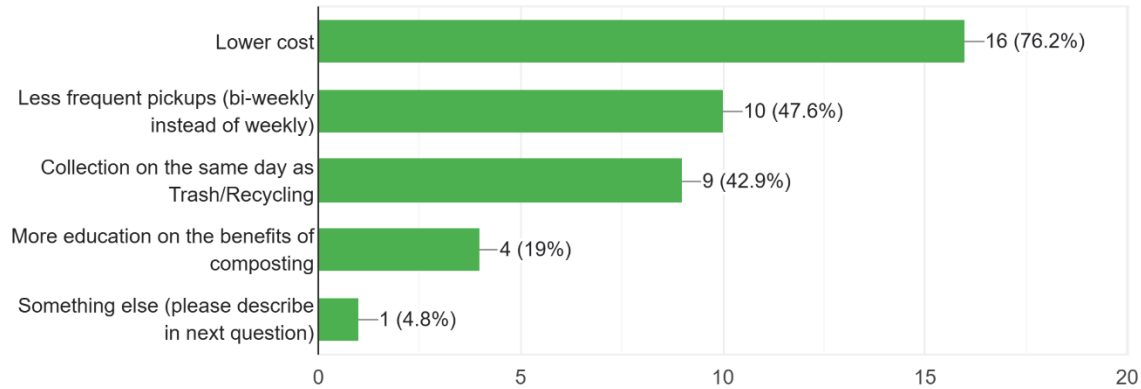
Would you recommend curbside food waste collection service to a friend or neighbor?

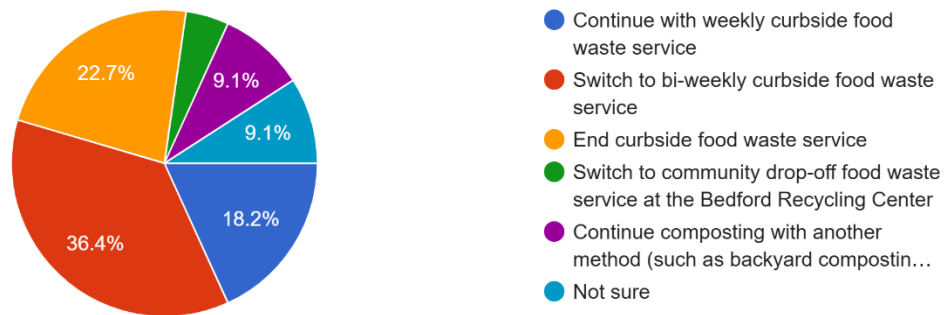


If you answered "something else" above, please share what would encourage you to continue to sort your food waste from the trash. 1 response
