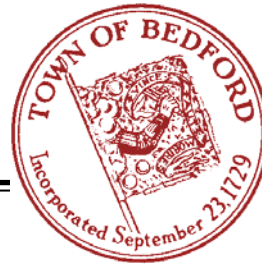

NOTICE OF WORK

To continue essential infrastructure inspections, the Bedford Public Works may be working in your neighborhood over the next few months.

Personnel from the Bedford DPW and a hired consultant, Tighe & Bond, will be inspecting stormwater outfall pipes throughout Town, to comply with the Town's EPA Stormwater Permit.

Our team will consist of 2 to 3 people wearing safety vests, masks, and carrying handheld equipment.

In addition to DPW utility vehicles, there will be personal vehicles. We will have a sign in the windshield of all vehicles indicating that the car is associated with a consultant supporting the Department of Public Works.

The work will be performed primarily off the roadway where the stormwater pipes discharge to wetlands, streams, or wooded areas. Some pipes may be located in residential backyards where an easement exists to allow the Town access to perform maintenance. Work may also include opening drainage structures within the road.

You are not required to take any action; this notification is to keep you informed.
