1. Is there urgency to the completion of this project? What are the ramifications if the project is delayed and/or not completed? Is this request to acquire a threatened resource? Please explain.
2. Will this project serve multiple needs and populations within Bedford? Will this project assist a currently under-served population? Please explain
3. Why is this project of value to Bedford?
4. How will this project preserve/enhance town assets?
5. How is this project consistent with Bedford's long range plans?
6. How does this project affect the environment?
7. Is it feasible to complete this project in the year for which funding has been requested? If not, explain. Please explain any other feasibility questions/issues?
